Any war is costly. Lasted for almost thirty years, including 8 years of the United States' direct intervention from 1965 to 1973, the Vietnam War was considered the most expensive war in Cold War era.

How Much Did The Vietnam War Cost?

Under the terms of Geneva Accords, France agreed to withdraw its troops from Indochina while Vietnam was temporarily divided into North and South Vietnam, led by Ho Chi Minh and Bao Dai respectively, at the 17 th parallel. Civilians were able to move freely between two states for a 300-day period.
